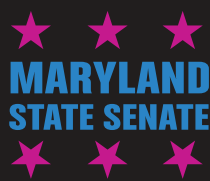

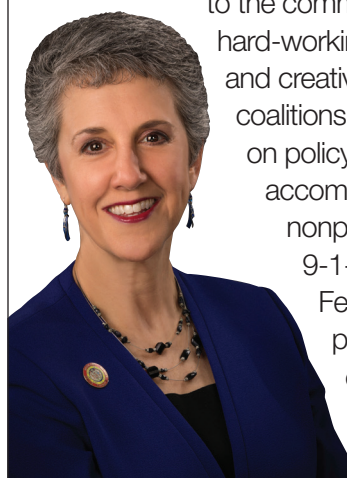

About State Senator Cheryl Kagan (District 17)

Sen. Kagan is completing her first, four-year term as the State Senator from District 17, Gaithersburg & Rockville. Prior to her election to the Senate, Kagan served eight years in the House of Delegates and returned to the community. She is known as a hard-working, independent, effective, and creative leader who builds broad coalitions in order to make progress on policy issues. Among her accomplishments are landmark nonprofit legislation; reform for our 9-1-1 system, Language Access, Fertility Parity, and protecting our personal data. Kagan has served on the Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs



Committee and the Joint Audit Committee and is the Senate Chair of the Joint Committee for the Management of Public Funds. The MD Municipal League has named her a "Superstar" for her advocacy on behalf of our cities and towns, and the MD Association of Counties made her "Legislator of the Year." Inducted into the Circle of Excellence after being named a "Top 100 Women" three times, Kagan was recognized as Government Leader of the year by the National NextGen911 Institute and the Newsome Award by the Center for Nonprofit Advancement. Senator Kagan lives in Rockville, where she frequently hosts "Folk 'N Great Music," her nationally known folk/acoustic house concert series for the past 16 years. She created, produced, and emceed the "UnNaugural" benefit concerts the past two years.
